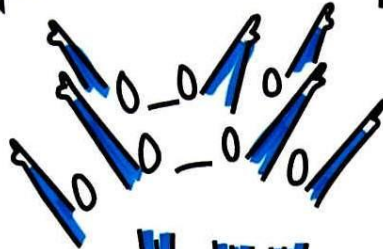

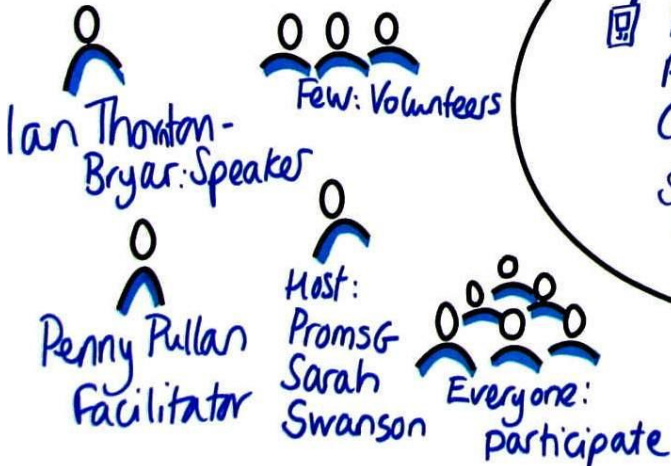

What really works on your risk workshops?

OPENNESS.
Honesty
Support
responsibility
no-blame culture
Empathy

BREAKS focus
Strict timescales
Humour
What is the schedule/cost.

A person to take minutes & facilitate + participant = scribe!
PUBLISH + CIRCULATE THEN
write the agreements to have to solve risks.
Regularity of communications

Solutions to issued risk.
Difference between task and meetings
Change to ask for "experts" to be brought in to provide advice
NO BLAME CULTURE / SHARED PROBLEMS.
